1. Purpose

EWA Tracker Ltd is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of all learners, staff and stakeholders. This policy sets out the arrangements for identifying, reporting and managing safeguarding concerns to ensure a safe learning environment.

2. Scope

This policy applies to all learners, staff, subcontractors and visitors involved in activities delivered by EWA Tracker Ltd.

3. Communication, Training and CPD

All staff receive safeguarding training as part of induction and undertake regular refresher training, including Prevent and KCSIE. Safeguarding updates form part of ongoing CPD, and records are maintained by the Centre Manager.

6. Reporting Procedure

All safeguarding concerns must be reported immediately to the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL). Reports may be made verbally or in writing and are recorded confidentially.

7. Investigation Process

The DSL will assess risk, take appropriate action, refer to external agencies where required, document actions taken and notify EAL where relevant.

8. Designated Safeguarding Person

Wayne Anthony Wright is the Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) for EWA Tracker Ltd.
